



# Shamwari Hunting Safaris – Zambia The REAL Africa



Zambia is by far – and I am biased! – the best country in Africa for hunting. Very often it is described as the real Africa with many large hunting concessions totally unspoilt by man, and very wild.



The concessions that I use for trophy hunting are considered prime areas within Zambia, lots of different flora and fauna in addition to stunning open skies make each safari an exceptional experience.

One of the other benefits of hunting in Zambia is the ability to purchase a Leopard package and then still be able to hunt both plains game and Buffalo under the same license. So for those attempting the Dangerous Seven this can be achieved far more quickly by harvesting four in one safari.

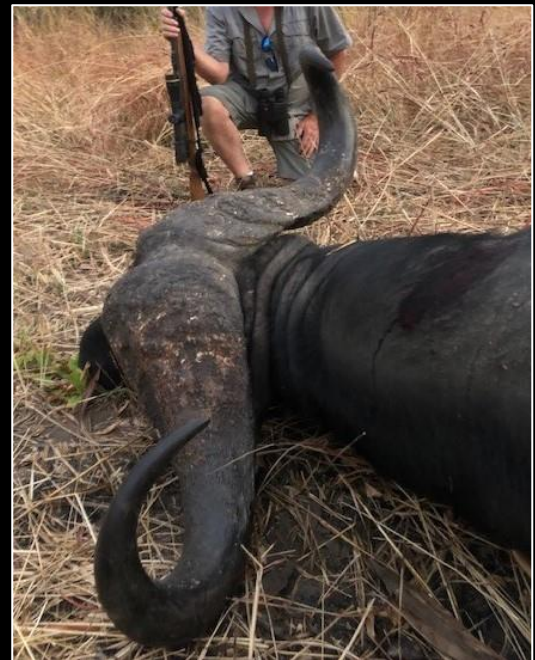
The hunting season is now fully kicked off and it's been a wonderful time so far.

Three different concessions have been utilised already and in the main Leopard have been the number one target for harvesting.

There was a real choice as to which cat to take and in addition we saw some outstanding Buffalo.



The concessions used were all based around the Luangwa river and with the normal downscale of the 'big' river the hippo have been superb with lots of big bulls grouped together.

There are a multitude of other species on offer as well, some of which are endemic to Zambia. One of which is the Cooksons Wildebeest a superb trophy of which was harvested on the borders of the Luwangwa River.



Puku are available in other countries but this is a great specimen of what can be found here.



This season has been very important to the local communities as well. The rains last year were very poor and lots of crops have failed, so it's of primary importance that we give back to the local communities with both meat and support to help them through these times.
